Delta County Republican Central Committee

Re-organization Meeting February 4, 2025

Rules

- 1. Election of Officers: Officers of the Central Committee shall be elected at the biennial Organizational Meeting. Each officer must be a duly registered elector affiliated with the Republican Party for at least one year immediately preceding his/her election to office (Bylaws Article III Officers, Section 3A.)
- 2. Nominations for any officer of the Central Committee may be made only by a member of the Central Committee who is present at the biennial Organizational Meeting. No second to any nomination is required, however any person, including nonmembers, may be recognized to second a nomination or endorsement. (Bylaws Article III Officers, Section 3B.)
- 3. Candidates will be given 4 minutes to present their Statement of Interest/Resume.
- 4. Committee members will be given 5 minutes to ask questions of the candidates following their presentation of their Statement of Interest/Resume.
- 5. The officers of the Central Committee shall be elected by a majority vote of those members of the County Central Committee present and voting. The election of Central Committee officers shall be conducted by secret ballot unless there is only one nominee for the office, in which case the election may be by voice vote. (Bylaws Article III Officers, Section 3C.)
- 6. No proxy voting. (Bylaws Article III Officers, Section 3D.)
- 7. The officers of the Central Committee shall assume their duties at the conclusion of the biennial Organizational Meeting (Bylaws Article III Officers, Section 1D).
- 8. The Vacancy Committee shall consist of not less than five nor more than seven members, representing each Commissioner District, of the Central Committee and shall be appointed by the Executive Committee and ratified by the Central Committee at each biennial Organizational Meeting (Bylaws Article IV Committees, Section 2 second Paragraph).
- 9. The Executive Committee shall appoint not less than three nor more than five persons to serve on the Bylaws Committee. The appointments shall be ratified by the Central Committee. (Bylaws Article IV Committees, Section 3).
